Living Waters Feeding Center celebrates 2nd Anniversary



July 18, 2010 marked the second year that your donations have helped change lives for 👞 the once "forgotten children of Kaswanga". Rewind two years ago when sixty five malnourished, diseased and frightened young children arrived at the newly constructed feeding center, complete with a gigantic strange thing called a "solar oven". It tookonly two days for the frightened faces to change to smiles, and soon the children were learning social responsibilities such as standing in line for their food, using appropriate manners, washing their own dishes and sweeping the floors of the feeding center. Thin malnourished bodies transformed into strong energetic youth who seemed to live with a purpose.

Currently one hundred and thirty five orphan children will walk up to four miles at lunch time to receive what may be their only meal for the day. It may be beans and maize (corn) or beans and rice or vegetables and ugali. Papaya and bananas are served fresh from the two acre garden which has drip irrigation to provide efficient watering. The children all receive one new school uniform a year and free basic medical care for malaria, worms, infections and other various diseases.

A water well was drilled and is operated by a solar pump which supplies eight storage tanks with a holding capacity of 60,000 liters.

Twenty one children who have learned of Gods love at the feeding center have been baptized and one of the six full time staff members is to be baptized soon.

Living Waters funding comes from individuals who are committed to using their resources in helping Gods children. This project is trusting that God will provide the means to continue. We need your help!



Amazing Progress 2010 Living Waters teams up to erect One-Day Churches

Living Waters International recently teamed up with Maranatha Volunteers International-ASI and the East African Union of Seventh-day Adventists to erect seventy four structures that will be utilized primarily as churches with a few for schools and medical clinics. The buildings were donated by Maranatha–ASI, the labor and accommodations provided by East African Union and the coordination and overall project supervision by Living Waters International.

Site locations include remote island villages in Lake Victoria, remote bush locations in the Kenyan interior, political displacement camps, Maasai villages and the Buru Buru slums of Nairobi.

All locations receiving churches are congregations that have no existing sanctuary and meet under trees or have buildings that have been condemned and are unsuitable for occupancy. The locations are selected jointly by the East African Union and Living Waters.

This is just the beginning of One-Day Churches and One-Day Schools in Kenya as additional containers have been requested to meet the overwhelming need for places of worship and schools in Kenya.

Living Waters provided on-site logistical organization which took three and one half months, equipment purchases for scaffolding, ladders, construction tools, a customized trailer for material movement and a vehicle purchase capable of traversing the wilds of Kenya.

The project target completion is eighteen months. Daryl's son Joby Oft who recently graduated from Pacific Union College has committed six months of on-site full time project management. Under his direction the project is ahead of schedule. Four young men from Kaswanga have been trained by Living Waters in the erection of these structures and have risen to meet the challenges of such a large undertaking.

Living Waters continues to rely on God impressing individuals to contribute to this worthy cause in order to keep the production on track. We are in serious need of funding for ongoing operational expense. Please allow God to use you in helping to build places of worship for the Kenyan people.
